

Using Final Cut Pro and Cleaner 5 EZ

Final Cut Pro is Apple's professional-level video editing software. Use Final Cut Pro to edit your file and export it as QuickTime movie before encoding it with Cleaner.


To export your file from Final Cut Pro and encode with Cleaner 5 EZ:

- 1 Highlight the clip you want to export and choose **File > Export > Final Cut Pro Movie**.
- 2 In the dialog that appears, make sure your settings are at the highest quality possible. If your project's current settings are not at a high quality, choose **Custom** from the **Setting** pull-down menu and reconfigure your settings.
- 3 Give your exported file a name and press the **Save** button.
- 4 Open the **Cleaner 5 EZ** application.
- 5 Drag your exported Final Cut movie to the Cleaner 5 EZ **Project** window. The first frame of your movie appears.
- 6 Choose a setting from the Settings menu at the bottom of the Project window.
- 7 Press the **Start** button to begin encoding.




You can also export a QuickTime movie that can be encoded using Cleaner 5 EZ.

- 1 Choose **File > Export > QuickTime**
- 2 In the dialog that appears, press the **Options** button. The Options dialog appears.
- 3 In the **Video** section, check the **Video** option and press the **Settings** button.




- 4 Configure the video settings as follows:
 - Choose **Animation** or **Motion JPEG A** in the **Compressor** pop-up menu
 - Move the **Quality** slider to **Best**.
 - In the **Motion** section, choose or enter **29.97** in the **Frames per second** pop-up menu.



- 5 Press the **OK** button.
- 6 In the Options dialog, check the **Sound** option and press the **Settings** button in the Sound section.

- 7 Configure the sound settings as follows:
 - Select **None** in the **Compressor** pop-up menu
 - Choose **44.100 kHz** for the Rate.
 - Choose **16 bit** for the Size.
 - Choose **Stereo** for the Use



- 8 Press the **OK** button.
- 9 Uncheck the **Prepare for Internet Streaming** option.
- 10 Enter a file name in the Save dialog box and press the **Save** button.
- 11 Open the **Cleaner 5 EZ** application.
- 12 Drag your exported QuickTime movie to the Cleaner 5 EZ Project window. The first frame of your movie appears.
- 13 Choose a setting from the Settings menu at the bottom of the Project window.
- 14 Press the **Start** button to begin encoding.
